So far we have been lucky in avoiding the early preview of winter we normally get, September at Didsbury High School has been relatively smooth and productive as students and staff have transitioned from summer vacation back to school. Students and staff are starting to get used to the concept and use of our Guided Learning Time and both groups have been using it to help with the completion of work, the administration of tests as well as the opportunity to give and receive extra support.

With a small class of grade 12's leaving us last year and a large group of grade 9's coming in DHS numbers are up by about 20 students this year -- a trend that is expected to continue over the next few years. 

#### GRADE NINE CONCERT BAND TOUR

The Grade Nine Concert Band will be traveling to the Regina Downtowners Optimist Band Festival in Regina, SK.

The Regina Optimist Band and Choral Festival is an outstanding, non-competitive festival that consistently brings in some of the finest adjudicators in North America to help school groups improve their skills. In addition, students will get to perform in the beautiful Conexus Arts Centre as part of their festival experience!

The dates for the tour would be Sunday, March 17<sup>th</sup> to Wednesday, March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

Cost for this trip would be approximately \$500.00, and would include transportation, accommodation, all festival fees and attractions and breakfast and supper daily. Although the festival is in Regina, we would be staying in Moose Jaw so that we could also take in the Tunnels of Moose Jaw, Temple Garden Spa and a concert in the historic Mae Wilson Theatre.

The DHS Band Society will be providing fundraising opportunities throughout the year in order to help as many students as possible take advantage of this outstanding travel opportunity.




